

**Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society**  
**2008 Edmonton Legal Build – Justice Cawsey Memorial Build**  
**Raffle 2007-2008**

**OFFICIAL RULES**  
**REVISED November 9, 2007**

1. **Tickets printed:** 2,500
2. **Ticket price:** \$10.00 per ticket. No volume discounts. Payment by cash, money order or cheque.
3. **Prize:** One cash prize of \$5,000.00 (the “Prize”), payable by cheque.
4. **Sale period:** 0900 November 29, 2007 to and including 1600 August 1, 2008. Unsold tickets shall be returned to Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society.
5. **Minors:** Raffle tickets shall not be sold to a person under the age of 18 years. In this regard, all ticket sellers must advise adult ticket buyers not to write the name of a person under the age of 18 years on the ticket.
6. **Draw Date:** 1200 August 29, 2008
7. **Location of Draw:** At the offices of Emery Jamieson LLP (1700 Oxford Tower, 10235 – 101 Street, Edmonton, Alberta)
8. **Manner of Draw:** see attached Schedule “A”.
9. **Restrictions:**
  - (1) Raffle tickets shall not be sold or advertised for sale outside the Province of Alberta.
  - (2) Only individuals may purchase raffle tickets.
  - (3) There are no other restrictions on who may purchase tickets or receive the Prize, other than as otherwise set forth in these Rules (see paragraph 5 above).
10. **Break-even point:** 560 tickets.
11. **Extension/Cancellation:** If, on July 1, 2008, fewer than 560 tickets have been sold, then the Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society will request an extension of the sale period to 1600 October 1, 2008 and an extension of the draw date to October 31, 2008 with AGLC approval.
12. **Refunds:** Tickets are non-refundable.

## Schedule “A” – Draw Procedure

1. Each sold ticket shall be eligible to participate in the draw conducted under the authority of a raffle licence.
2. Prior to the draw, Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society shall reconcile the number of sold tickets and unsold tickets with the number of ticket stubs in draw container.
3. Each ticket stub containing the ticket serial number of each sold ticket must be placed in the draw container. Only the ticket serial number can be used to determine a winner.
4. Ticket stubs shall be drawn from a container that is transparent or constructed with mesh so that tickets stubs can be seen from the outside.
5. Two (2) members of the Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society and at least three members of the public who are not members of Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society shall be present at the draw as witnesses, as well as one person who does not own a ticket or a share of a ticket (the “Selector”).
6. Prior to the draw, the ticket stub container must be rotated or the contents of the container agitated a minimum of three times to ensure the random location of each ticket stub within the container. Anti-static spray may be used to facilitate the rotation of ticket stubs.
7. The winning ticket must be manually drawn from the container in a random manner.
8. The arm of the Selector must be “bare” of clothing below the elbow and they must exhibit their draw arm and both sides of their open hand to the draw witnesses, immediately prior to making the draw.
9. Only the Selector may put their arm/hand in the draw container.
10. When selecting the winning ticket, the Selector shall look away from the container in the direction of the witnesses.
11. A record of the winning ticket shall be made indicating the ticket serial number, the name, address, phone number of the prize-winner and the time and date the ticket was drawn.
12. The winning ticket shall be immediately exhibited to witnesses and held open for inspection until the end of the draw.
13. In the event that the winning ticket stub has more than one name on it, Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society shall award the Prize to only one of the individuals identified on the ticket, such individual being determined by Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society in its sole discretion. Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society and the

- Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (the “AGLC”) shall not be responsible for any disputes which may arise between the different individuals whose names appear on a winning ticket stub.
14. Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society shall contact the winning ticket holder by telephone or other means and shall make arrangements to deliver the Prize. The winning ticket holder must provide proof of age (over 18) and proof of identification prior to the Prize being awarded.
  15. The winning ticket holder has one year from the date of the draw to claim the Prize. If the Prize has not been claimed within this period of time, Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society may donate the Prize to a charitable beneficiary approved by the AGLC.
  16. The draw shall be open to the public.
  17. Habitat for Humanity Edmonton Society shall retain all tickets with the raffle records for two years after the last draw date.
